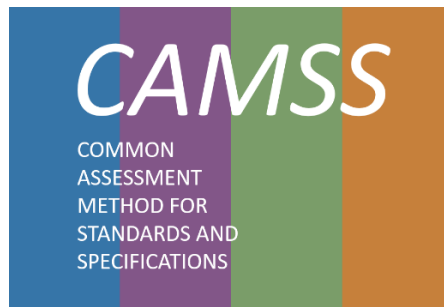

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. Objective and purpose

A CAMSS Assessment is a solution which corresponds to the output of an assessment of a standard, technical specification or standard developing/setting organisation using the CAMSS Tools. The version of the CAMSS Tools used for the performance of the assessments was v3.0.0.

1.2. Release date

This version of the CAMSS Assessment of HTML5 has been released on the 31th of March 2020 in Joinup.

1.3. Description

CAMSS Assessment of HTML5 v1.0.0 was released on the 31th of March 2020. This assessment has been performed following the scenario “EIF” using the CAMSS Tools. The purpose of this scenario is assessing the compliance of a standard or technical specification with the European Interoperability Framework (EIF)¹.
