What is SIQAT?

SIQAT is a European **online tool** which supports the assessment of the Interoperability Maturity level of Public Service, from the structural perspective.

Interoperability

in a digital public service *is defined as:*

The extent it enables peer-to-peer collaboration with [public] services towards mutually beneficial goals, involving the exchange of data, information and knowledge between them regardless their legal, organizational, semantic and technical environment.
