SIQAT V1.0.0 EU SURVEY

The Structural Interoperability Quick Assessment tool supports a short and comprehensive questionnaire, to collect information on the solution from the solution owner, in order to automatically calculate its Structural Interoperability Score. The online assessment tool includes two key aspects: Shareability and (Re)usability, with closed answers, and implements the defined Structural Interoperability Scoring Model. Different structural criteria exist for Software Components and Services due to their distinct nature. The tool is implemented in EU survey in order to be easily used by any solution owner.
