# Other initiatives on interoperability

#### eGovernment Strategy

Context: One of the main objectives of the Liechtenstein eGovernment strategy (2011), setup by the Parliament, is to make state information systems citizen-oriented and service-based. Information systems have to be integrated into a single logical whole serving the population, enterprises and organisations. Interoperability is mainly driven by the eGovernment initiatives and is considered service-based and usage-oriented and should be put in context due to the relative small size of the country.

Principles: Basic components/ systems components need to be reusable, enabling projects to easily build new services and applications. Liechtenstein takes the best practices of other countries into account regarding interoperability.

Effectiveness: The Project Manager has the main responsibility to make use of the already existing components and services. Internal monitoring is done via the project office. An external company does periodic reviews.
