## Main interoperability activities

Slovakia plans to finalise their NIF in the next year (2013).

## **Summary of the NIF**

No NIF has been developed yet for Slovakia.

#### Alignment NIF/EIF

Currently Slovakia has no NIF yet. Slovakia has concrete plans to develop a NIF for which the recommendations of the EIF will be taken into account. The NIF/EIF alignment will be made after the formal publication of the Slovak NIF.

# Other initiatives on interoperability

The **Standards for Public Administration Information Systems**<sup>1</sup> are available on the website of the Ministry of Finance; they are continuously updated and by a decree enforced on the public administrations.

The **eGovernment Strategy**<sup>2</sup> sets out the strategic objectives of eGovernment implementation and defines particular steps towards the modernisation of public administration and digitisation of its services.

The **National Concept of eGovernment**<sup>3</sup> lays down the architecture of integrated information systems in public administration and specifies the standards for their building, with the aim of ensuring their interoperability and their independence from technology platforms.

**Work in progress:** A central architecture document is being revised and should be finalised by the end of the year (2012). At the same time the relevant legislation is being prepared, upon acceptance of this legislation the architecture may need to be adapted.
