About ISA




ISA is undertaking a number of initiatives to promote reuse of interoperability assets

About Joinup








We have identified many infrastructures that promote the sharing and reuse of interoperability assets both from European Member States as well as standardisation bodies and European Institutions.



...And who is interested to find such assets?




André would like to find standards, specifications, tools or services specific to the exchange of social security information between public administrations




ASSET DESCRIPTION METADATA SCHEMA






However, the current catalogue does not allow to explore assets from all layers of interoperability


