

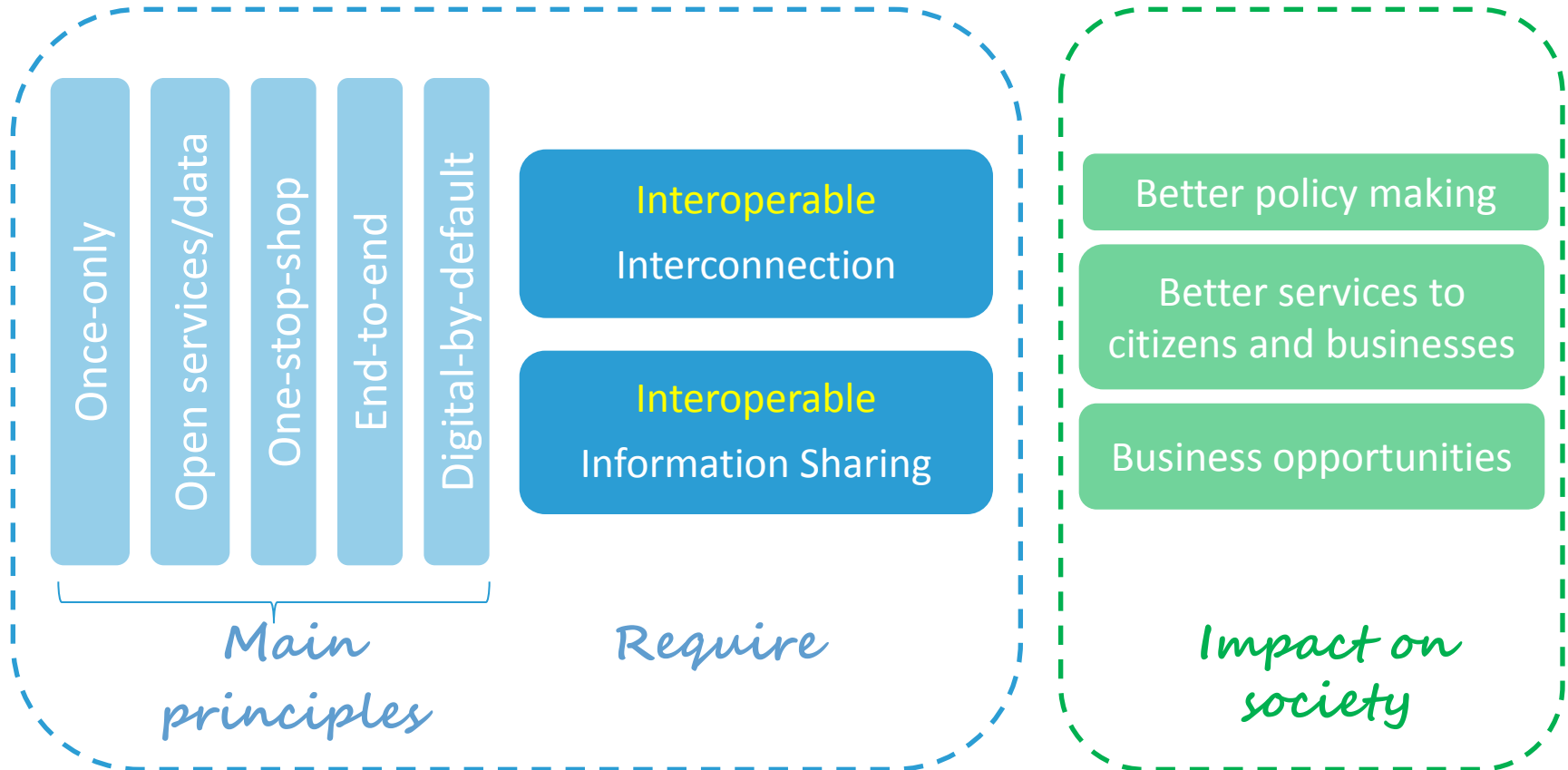

Big data and cloud



Digital data stored in cloud: **2013: 20% - 2020: 40%**

The use of big data by the top 100 EU manufacturers could lead to **savings worth €425 billion**

Unlocking e-commerce potential



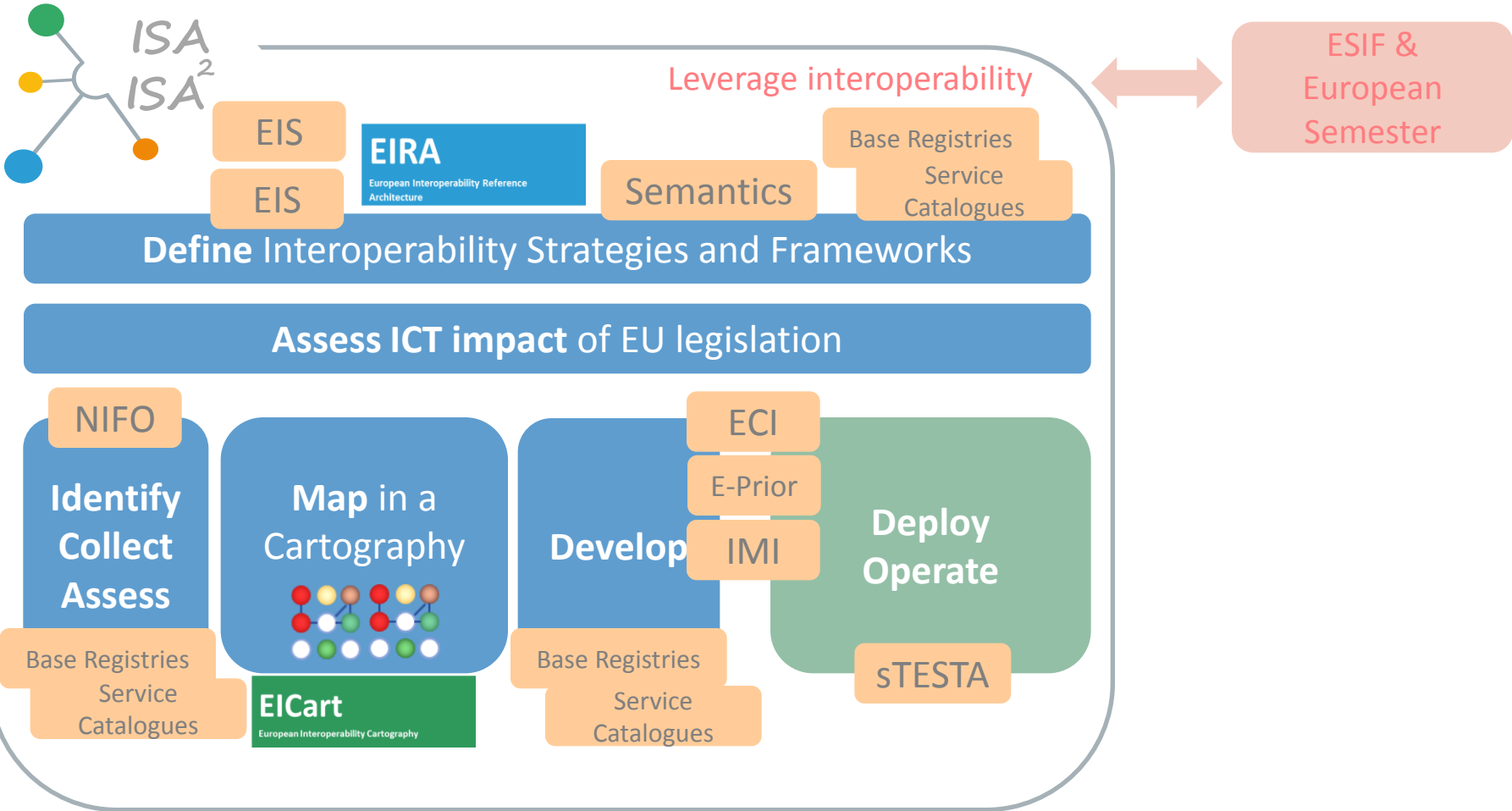
15% of consumers bought online from other EU countries in 2014 while **44%** did so **domestically**

72% of Internet users in Europe still worry that they are being asked for too much **personal data online**





The objective

The ISA² programme shall **facilitate** efficient and effective electronic **cross-border or cross-sector** interaction between **European public administrations** and between them and **citizens and businesses**.



- Will run from 2016 until 2020, aligned with the Multi-annual Financial Framework (MFF)
- Will have a financial envelope of approx. 131 M€
- Will receive proposals from Member States and Commission services
- Will be executed by the European Commission

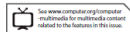
