1. INTRODUCTION

With this tool, all steps in a survey life cycle are covered, from the design to the launch of the survey to the analysis and publication of results.

It features different types of multiple-choice questions, free text fields as well as more complex elements like editable tables and gallery elements.

Results can be displayed as histograms, percentages or in full details and can be exported to different formats. All submitted answers (or a sub-set) can be published automatically on a dedicated webpage within the application.

2. ABOUT THIS RELEASE

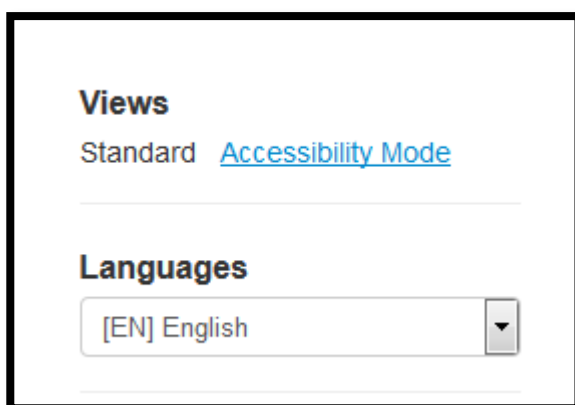
This document communicates the modifications implemented in EUSurvey 1.3.1.

Those include newly implemented features, improvements to enhance the usability of the application, as well as several bug fixes.

3. NEW FEATURES

3.1. WCAG mode for all questionnaires

Every participant can now enter a WCAG 2.0 AA compliance mode of the opened questionnaire by clicking on the "Accessibility Mode" link in the info box in the top right corner of the page.



3.2. Password security for published results

Form Managers now have the possibility to secure the published results of their survey with a password. This is not a mandatory option, but can be used to prevent unwanted eyes from having access to the published results.

3.3. Column width options for Table Element

New options to define the column width of a table element have been added.

1. Fit to content
2. Fit to page
3. Manual column width

The default is "Fit to content". In this mode, the system will dynamically adjust the column width to the text in the header of the table. In the "Fit to page" mode, the table will take the whole width of the page. The third mode "Manual column width" allows the user to adjust the width of each column manually.



3.4. Usage of LDAP and SSO

If you have your own LDAP / Active Directory infrastructure you can integrate your data into the application. But you need to use the open source Jasig solution as SSO (make the bridge between the application and the LDAP data). 4. DIFFERENT ENHANCEMENTS TARGETING SYSTEM'S USABILITY

4.1. Security improvements

Several measures have been taken to furtherly increase the security of the application against identity fraud or data manipulations.

4.2. Download PDF copy of contribution from EUSurvey Homepage

Users can now retrieve their submitted contribution as a PDF file from the EUSurvey homepage, when providing the Case-ID of their contribution.



5. DIFFERENT BUG-FIXES AFFECTING THE SYSTEM'S USABILITY

5.1. Calculation of statistics for deleted questions

The statistics for deleted questions did not finish calculating. This has been fixed.

5.2. Properties cannot be changed

A bug has been fixed which prevented any changes in the Properties of a survey from being saved.

5.3. Special characters in PDF export of statistics

In the PDF export of one survey's statistics, there was a bug which prevented special characters from being escaped correctly.
