- INVITING CONTRIBUTIONS THAT CAN ADVOCATE FOR POSITIVE CONSIDERATION OF HUMAN ACTORS IN THE CYBER ECOSYSTEM.
- SEEKING PAPERS THAT CAN CONTRIBUTE TO THIS MESSAGE: THE HUMAN ELEMENT AS THE LAST LINE OF DEFENCE IN CYBER

- SUBMIT AN ABSTRACT OF ONE/1 PAGE PDF WITH MAIN IDEAS INCLUDING AUTHOR NAME AND AFFILIATION, BY 28/06/2020 NEW DEADLINE.
- ALL SUBMISSIONS WILL BE REVIEWED BY 2 PC MEMBERS AND RECEIVE FEEDBACK. ACCEPTED PAPERS SHOULD BE READY BY 18/07 AND
 1. BE PROMOTED THROUGH PRESENTATIONS IN CONFERENCES LIKE CYBERSHARE CONFERENCE, APWG AWARENESS SUMMIT, ROUND TABLES AND WORKSHOPS;
 2. BE PUBLISHED IN A JOURNAL SIMILAR TO 2019 CALL;
 3. BE INVITED TO ATTEND 'THE INTERNATIONAL CYBER LAB AT THE BLACK SEA' IN 2021;
