




Background / 1

- AgID is in charge of managing the 2 national Catalogues for spatial data (RNDT – geodati.gov.it) and open data (dati.gov.it);
- In case of open spatial data, Italian PAs document data:

• either in one of the two Catalogues







Background / 2


Three-Year Plan 2019-2021 for ICT in the Public Administration


Action LA15









GeoDCAT-AP_IT API

How GeoDCAT-AP_IT API works





The (open) issues in GeoDCAT-AP_IT

- Open data resources not easily identifiable in the Catalogue for Spatial Data mainly due to the license not clearly documented (e.g. by an URI);
- Geodata not easily identifiable in the Open Data portal;
- Limited use of URI (e.g. for the format metadata element) and no possible mapping between free text and values coming from a controlled vocabulary;
- No possible mapping in some cases (e.g. dct:modified in case of no revision date in INSPIRE metadata).

Benefits



- Avoid the double burden on PAs concerning the documentation of open geodata in both Catalogues;
- Overcome the possible misalignments between the metadata published in the two catalogues;
- Ensure data is always up to date to the users;
- Improve the discovery experience for the users.
