
Why Joinup @ S&R conference ?

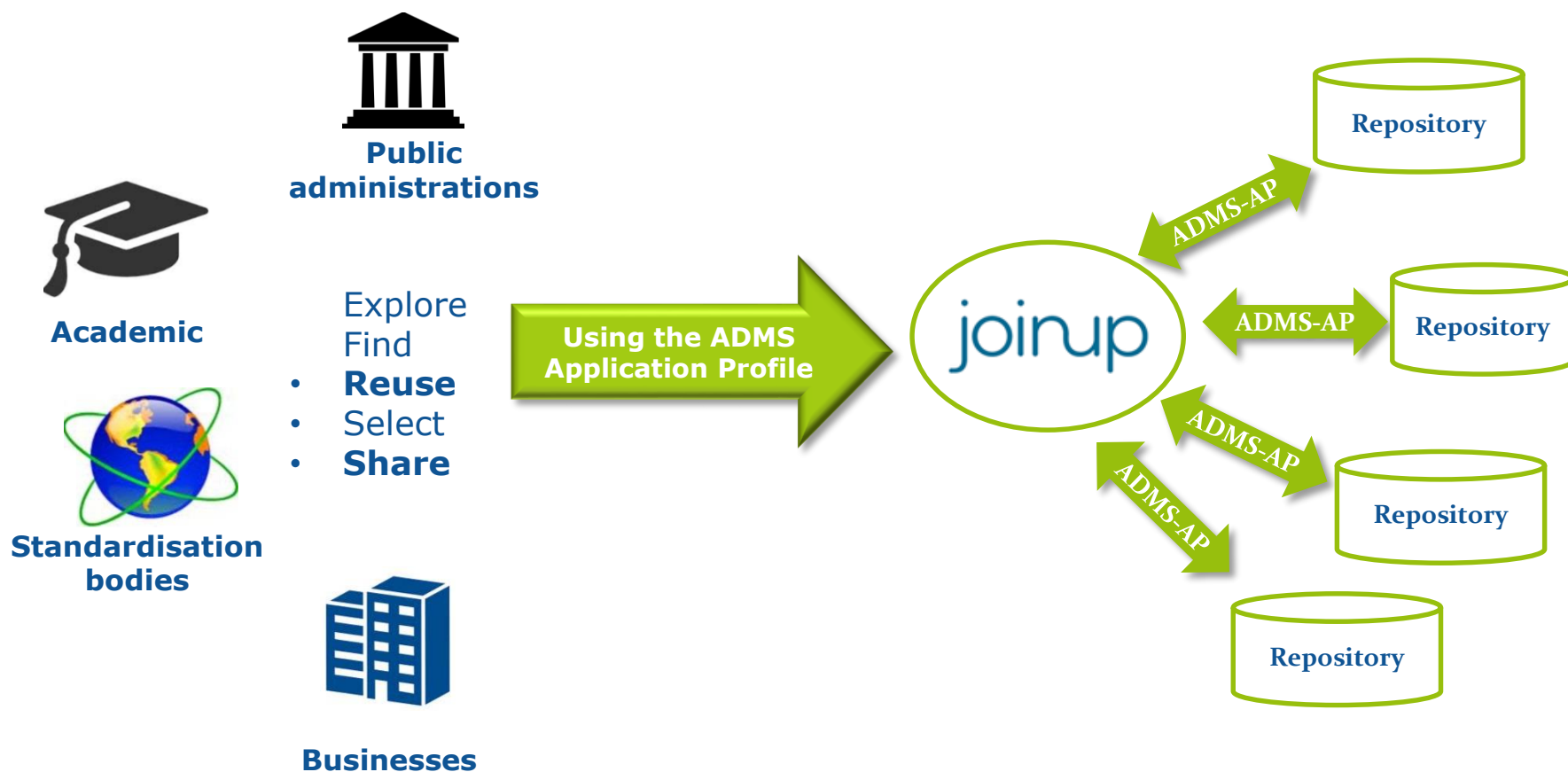

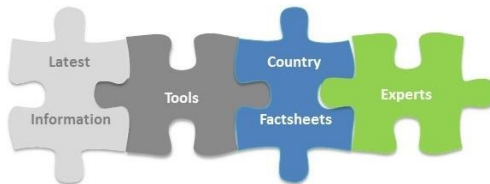

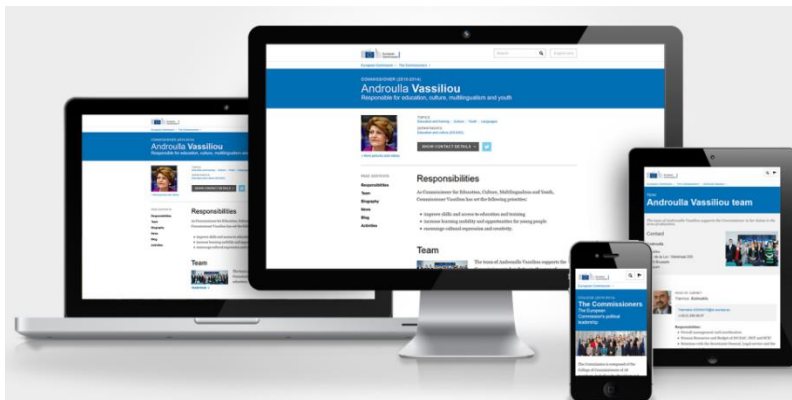
