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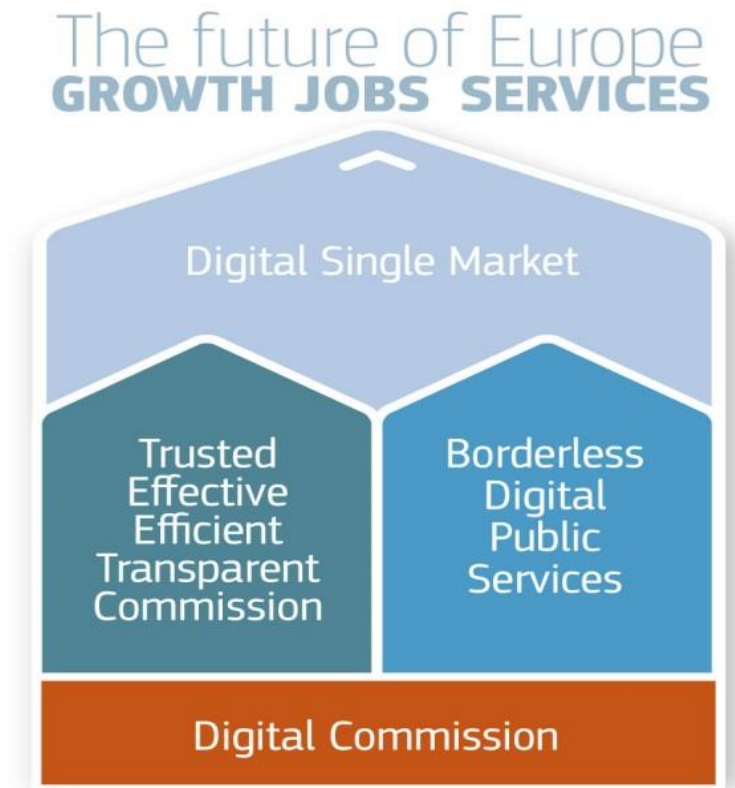

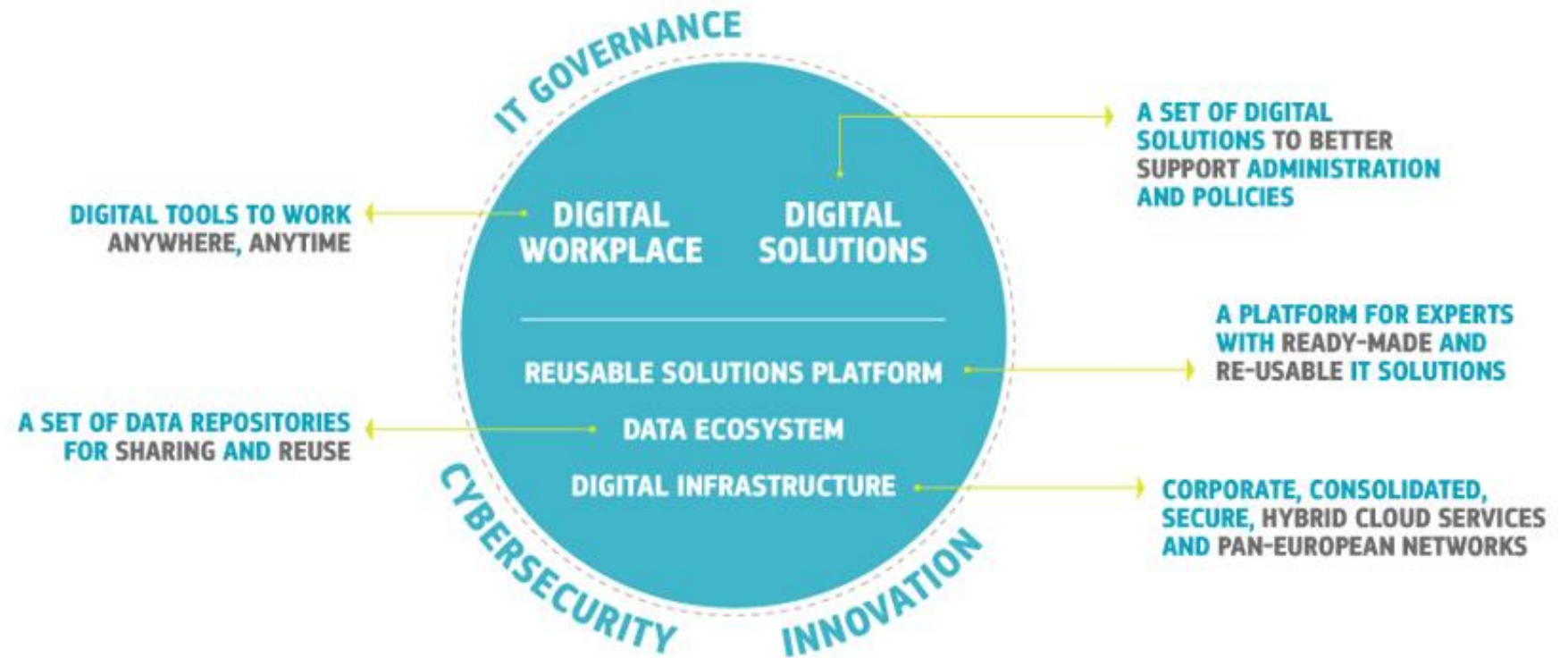

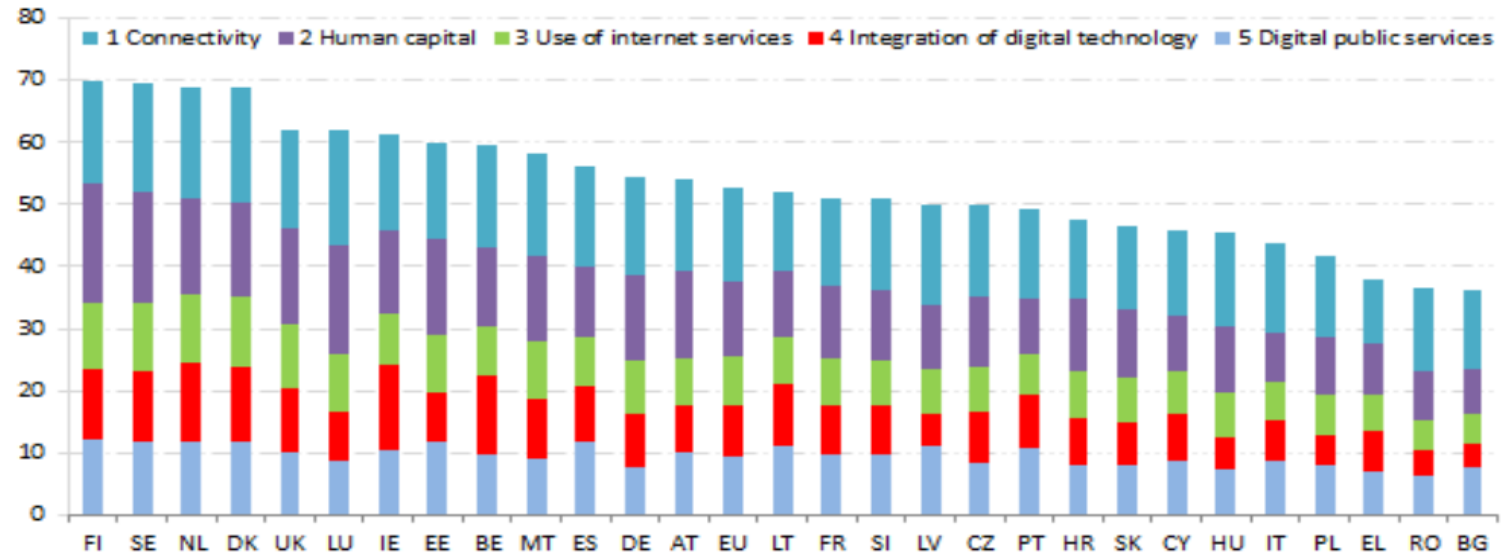
## The picture:

Uneven public sector progress across EU

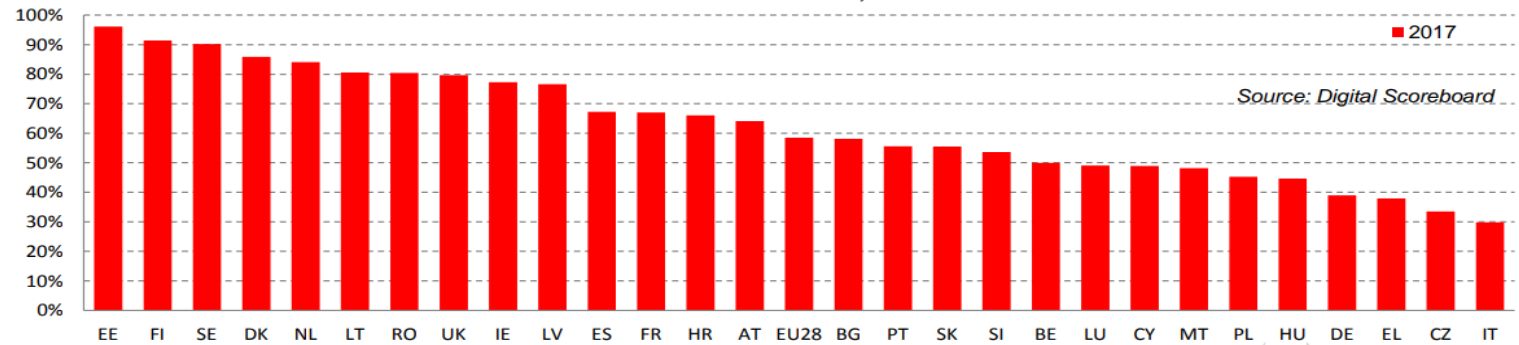
## The value:

# Towards a European Government Interoperability mechanism - 2

## A joint commitment by EU Member States:

- ...
- eGovernment is significant for the development of the data economy and the Digital Single Market, especially for ensuring the secure and free movement of data as an enabler for digital innovation in Europe and for reducing the costs of and barriers to seamless functioning of the Single Market.
- ...
- The digital transformation of the public administration is our collective endeavour at national, regional and local levels within our countries as well as by the EU institutions<sup>5</sup>, respecting the division of competences. Our efforts can be greatly facilitated by collaboration, interoperable solutions and sharing of good practices throughout public administrations and across borders.
- ...

### Annex: User-centricity principles for design and delivery of digital public services

We, the ministers in charge of policy and coordination of digital public services in the countries of the European Union (EU) and the European Free Trade Area (EFTA), recognise the needs and expectations of our citizens and businesses as they interact with public administrations. We commit that the design and delivery of our services will be guided by the following principles of user-centricity.



- Digital Interaction
- Accessibility, security, availability and usability
- Reduction of the administrative burden
- Digital delivery of public services
- Citizen engagement
- Incentives for digital service use
- Protection of personal data and privacy
- Redress and complaint mechanisms

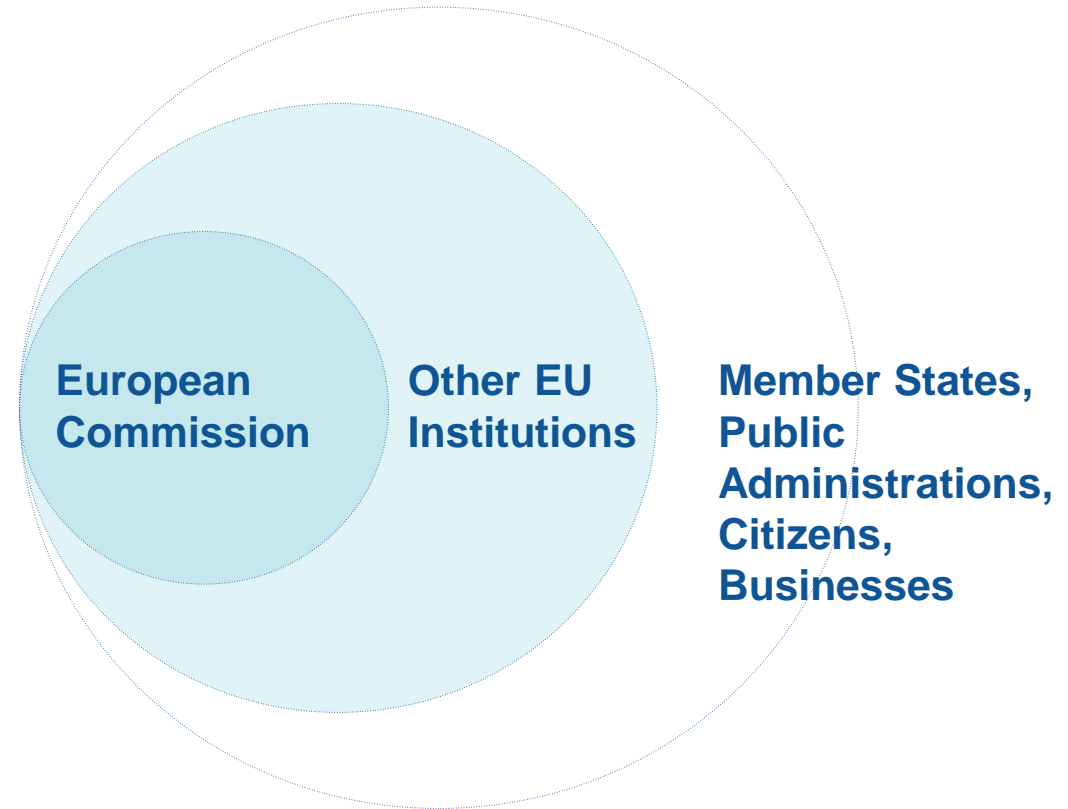
