Political Communications

On 5 May 2022, the government launched a new national strategy for digitalisation for 2022-2026. The strategy consists of 9 visions and 61 specific initiatives, constituting the main lines for the next chapter in Denmark's digital development.

Legislation

The [Act Amending the Law on the Reuse of Public Sector Information of 10 May 2021](#) implements the Open Data Directive 2019/1024 of 20 June 2019, which is a recast of the former Directive 37/2013/EU and Directive 2003/98/EC on the re-use of public sector information.

Governance

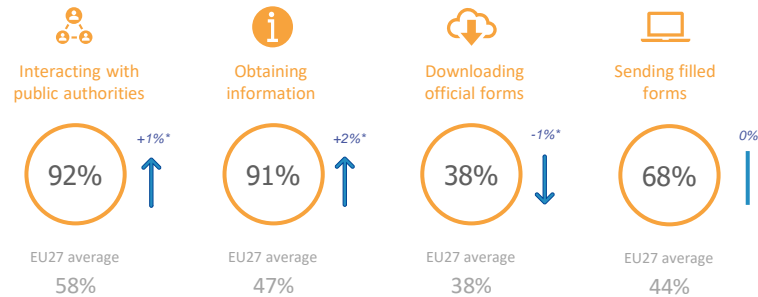
No recent changes in governance have been reported to date.

Infrastructure

In 2021 and 2022 Denmark will migrate all existing [NemID](#) users to the new MitID solution, which directly translates into "MyID". The MitID solution is developed in a well-established partnership between the Danish public sector and Finance Denmark, the Danish business association for banks and other financial institutions.

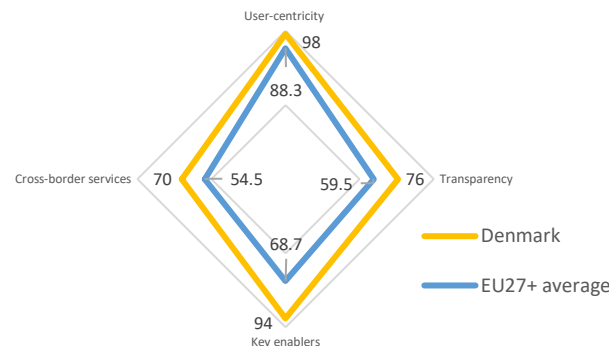
Percentage of individuals using the internet for

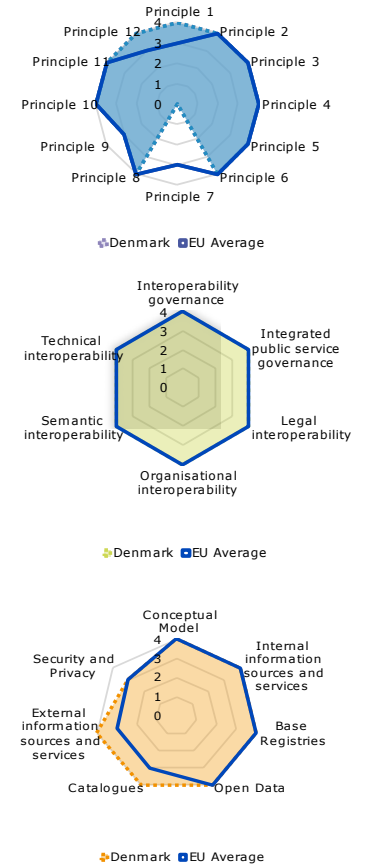
eGovernment indicators
