Political Communications

In 2021 with the appointment of the Minister for technological innovation and digital transition (MITD), a new [plan "Italia digitale 2026"](#) was issued as well as a new [IT National Interoperability Framework](#).

Legislation

After approval of the [Simplification and Digital Innovation Decree](#) in February 2021, all administrations are required to migrate from the various online authentication methods to the Public Digital Identity System - SPID and the Electronic Identity Card.

Governance

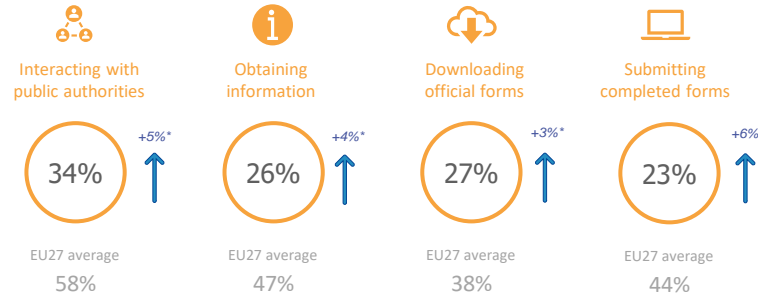
The provisions of Decree No 82 of 14 June 2021 established the [National Agency for Cybersecurity](#). The Agency is in charge of safeguarding the national interest in the area of cybersecurity, including the protection of cyber-defence interest.

Infrastructure

Dati.gov.it is the national catalogue of open data of Italian public administrations. It was created with the aim of aggregating in a single portal most of the open data exposed by the various administrations, both local and national.

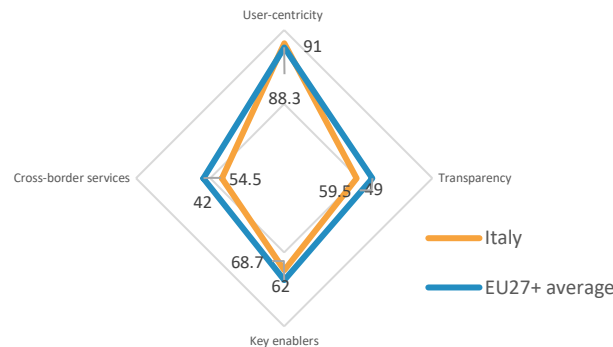
Percentage of individuals using the internet for

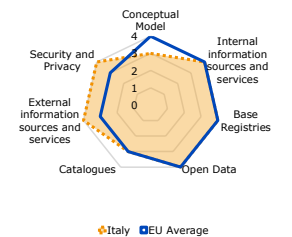
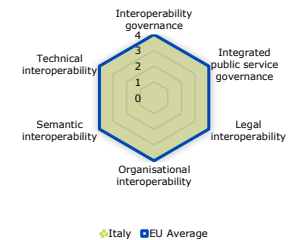
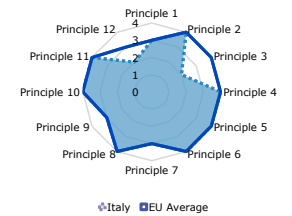
eGovernment indicators
