Legislation

While no new legislation pertaining to digital public administration has been published recently in Norway, several acts related to digital public administration are currently being revised, such as the [Public Administration Act](#) and the [Archival Act](#).

Governance

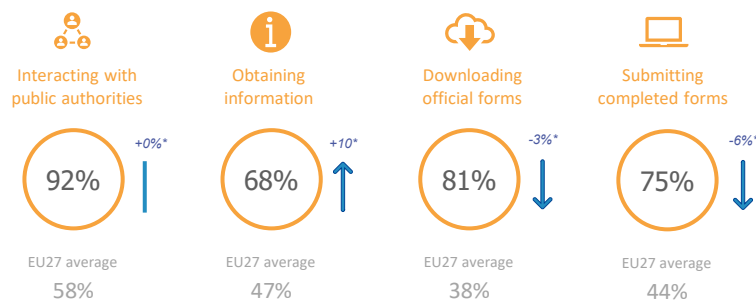
In 2020, the [Norwegian Digitalisation Agency](#) was established. The agency is the Norwegian government’s foremost tool for faster and more coordinated digitalisation of the Norwegian public sector.

Infrastructure

Norway has developed a broad portfolio of national common digital solutions. Some of these are mandatory for state-level enterprises to use or consider, as outlined in the Digitalisation Circular; others are voluntary.

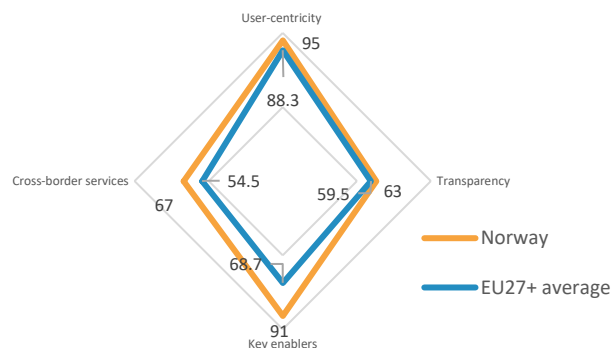
Percentage of individuals using the internet for

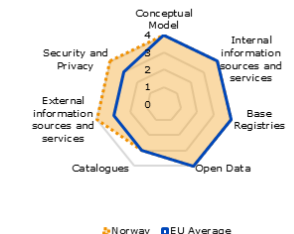
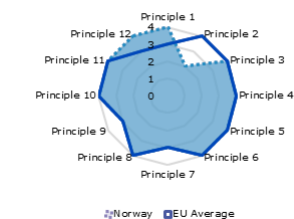
eGovernment indicators
