

## Political Communications

In February 2020, the Ministry of Innovation Technology and Digitalisation launched the [National Innovation Plan 2025](#). In June 2019, Italy published its [Fourth Open Government Partnership Action Plan](#). The plan aims at transforming the relationship between citizens and the public sector.

## Governance

## Legislation

In November 2019, the [Law no. 133](#) on Urgent Measures in the Field of National Cybersecurity was published in the Official Gazette.

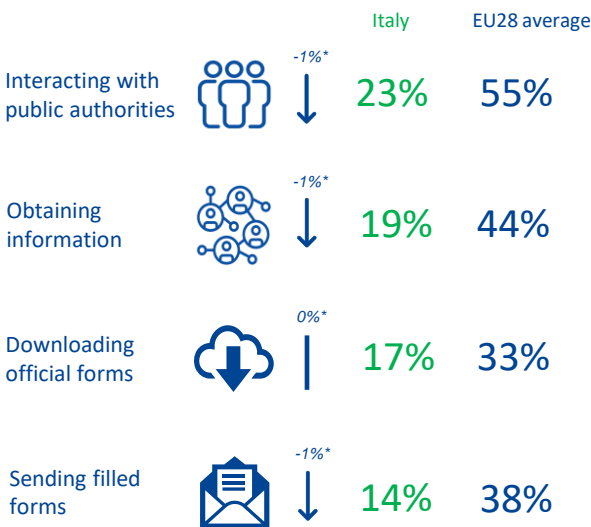
The [Decree of 8 August 2019](#) defined the rules to implement the Italian Computer Emergency Response Team (CSIRT).

Percentage of individuals using the internet for

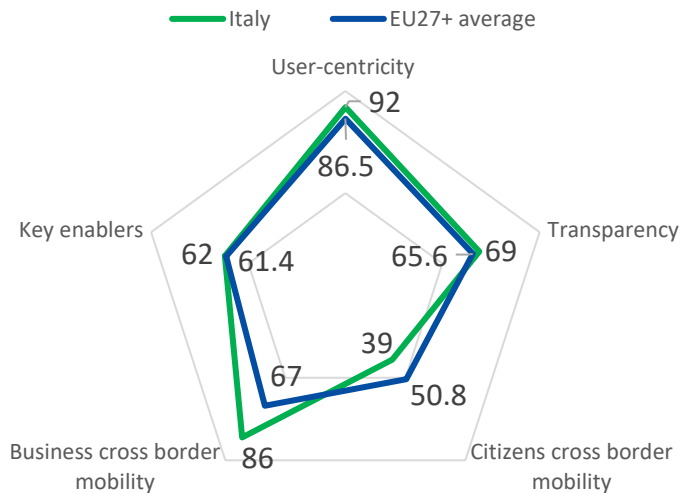

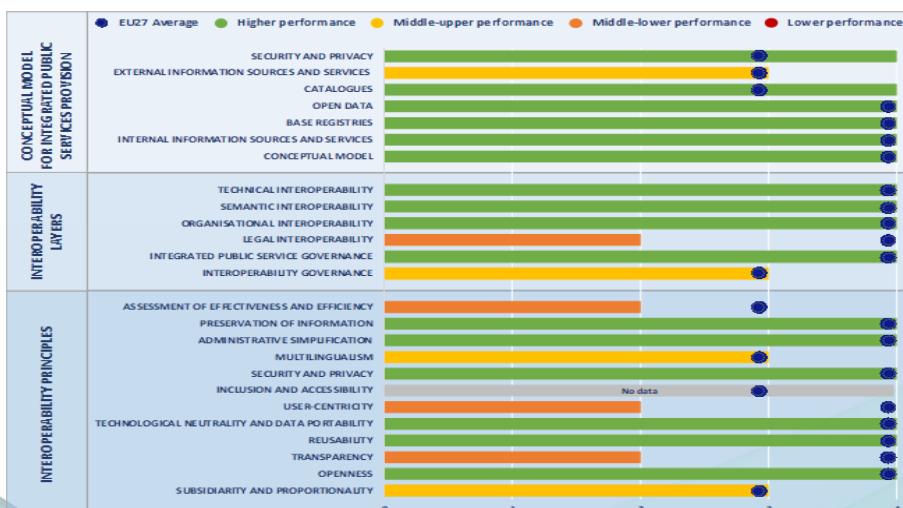
## eGovernment indicators
