<b>Short description</b>	<p>The EU Open Data Portal is the single point of access to a wide range of data held by EU institutions, agencies and other bodies. The portal is a key element of EU open data strategy. The portal allows anyone to easily search, explore, link, download and reuse the data for commercial or non-commercial purposes, through a catalogue of common metadata. Through this catalogue, users access data stored on the websites of the EU institutions, agencies and other bodies.</p> <p>Semantic technologies offer new functionalities. The metadata catalogue can be searched via an interactive search engine (Data tab) and through SPARQL queries (Linked data tab). There is also a showcase of visualisation applications from various EU institutions, agencies and other bodies. Users can suggest data they would like the portal to be linked to, give feedback on the quality of data obtainable and share information with other users about how they have used it.</p> <p>The interface is in 23 EU official languages, while most metadata are currently available in a limited number of languages (English, French and German). Some of the metadata (e.g. names of the data providers, geographical coverage) are in 23 languages following the translation of controlled vocabulary lists that are used by the portal.</p>
