The Climate and Environment Strategy for the Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Sector, Finland's first strategy of this kind, was published on 9 March 2021. This pioneering strategy proposes instruments that will reduce the carbon and environmental footprint of the ICT sector, and help reap the benefits of digitalisation. More in general, the purpose of the national Climate and Environment Strategy for the ICT Sector is to promote ecologically sustainable digitalisation, and support the achievement of the climate and environment objectives.

A new section of the <u>Act on Information Management in Public Administration</u> (906/2019) entered into force in May 2023. The section requires that public authorities notify other authorities relying on their information systems and datasets pools if those systems or datasets are disrupted or under threat of disruption.
