Political Communications

[Ireland's Third ICT Skills Action Plan 2022](#) is a plan to meet the country's high-level ICT skills needs. This action plan sets out to achieve a step-change in Ireland's supply performance, through a focused set of impactful actions that will underpin the State's continuing status as a global centre for high-level ICT talent. This ambition is being realised through a concerted partnership approach between government, industry, and the education and training sector.

Legislations

The model [Data Sharing Agreement template](#), linked to the [2019 Data Sharing and Governance Act](#) and designed to assist public service bodies further, was published in June 2022.

Infrastructures

In May 2022, the [Minister of State for Trade, Promotion, Digital and Company Regulation](#) appointed Ireland's first AI Ambassador. This new AI Ambassador will lead a national conversation on the role of AI in our lives, emphasising Ireland's commitment to an ethical approach to the use of the technology and in particular its adoption by enterprise.

Governance

The Digital Issues Senior Officials' Group, a sub-group of the Cabinet Committee on Economic Recovery and Investment, which is chaired by the Tánaiste, has been established and meets regularly to oversee implementation of the national digital strategy, [Harnessing Digital](#), and reports on its progress annually. The Group also oversees relevant EU and regulatory issues and input to the national Digital Decade Strategic Roadmap.
