Luxembourg's Government has adopted in 2022 an <u>open data strategy</u>, together with a 5 year roadmap. In a circular letter the Prime Minister gave <u>official instructions</u> about concrete actions to be undertaken by the governments' organisations in this context. A (draft) law and a platform are being developed to facilitate the digitization of public administration, facilitate the conclusion of administrative acts in digital form. The bill and program are expected to be passed before the fall of 2023.

In February 2022, the ministry launched the new GouvID mobile app, developed by the Government IT-Center (CTIE). This app offers citizens the possibility to use their electronic identity card (eID) in conjunction with their smartphone to authenticate with different digital state services such as MyGuichet.lu. The GouvID app also allows to sign online administrative procedures that require an electronic signature.

No recent changes in governance have been reported to date.
