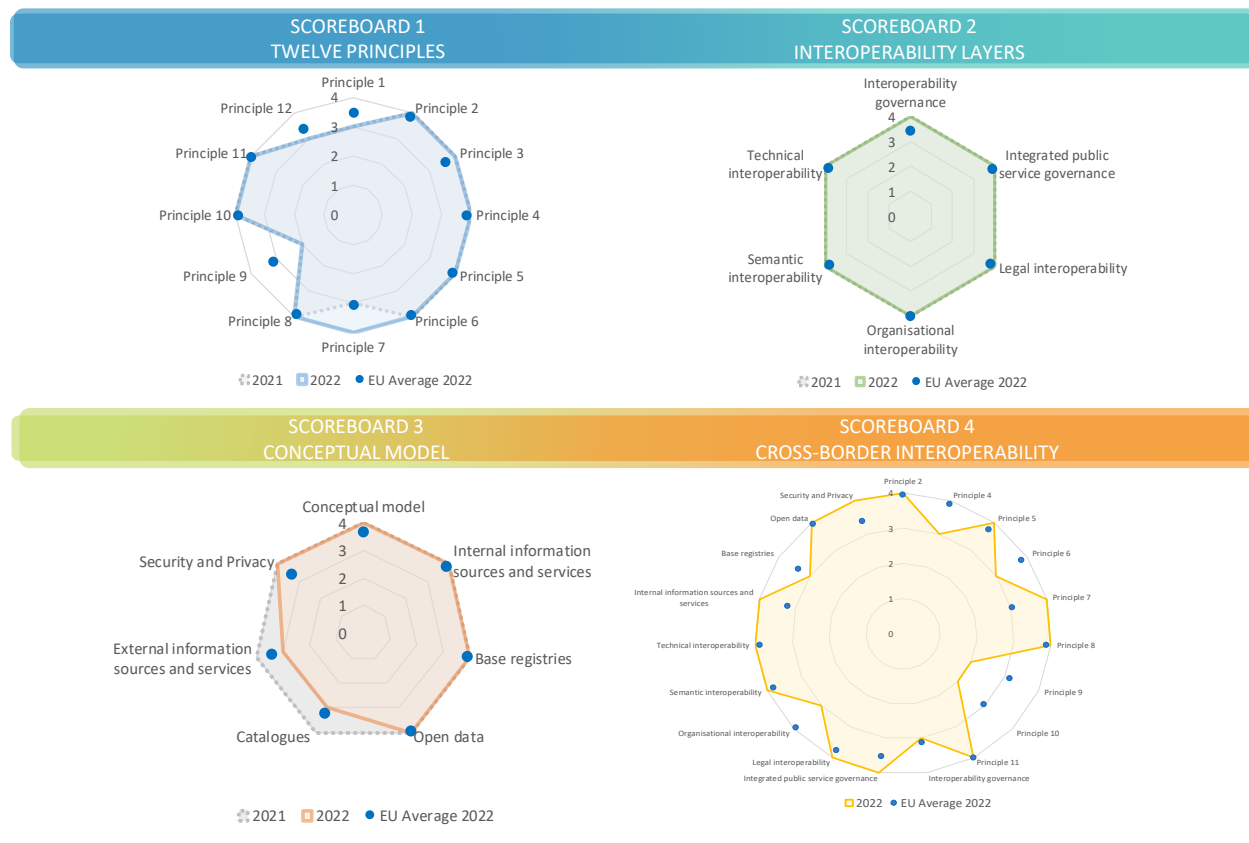

On December 2022, the government of the Slovak Republic approved [Action Plan for Digital Transformation of Slovakia 2023 - 2026](#) aimed at increasing digitalization of Slovak economy and targeting especially small and medium enterprises and innovative businesses. It focuses also on developing and deploying top digital technologies and building a resilient society. It defines framework for promoting productivity, knowledge economy, focusing on higher value-added segments, more competitive economy and sustainable development.

After 10 years of experience with regulation laid down by Act No. 305/2013 Ministry of Investments, Regional Development and Informatization of the Slovak Republic has decided that is necessary to adopt a new act on eGovernment. The new act on eGovernment naturally abandons that idea and aims to create a comprehensive digital alternative for official agenda based on current needs and contemporary possibilities of information technologies. Legislative works on new act on eGovernment has been initiated at the end of year 2022 and it is expected to continue throughout the year 2023.

On June 20, 2022, the first phase of the Slovakia in mobile (SvM) project was presented. It enables access to the government electronic services such as slovensko.sk portal or the electronic mailboxes via a smartphone using mobile key meaning that users can login into government services without an ID card reader. Slovakia in mobile is gradually being implemented in several phases. The first step is the Mobile ID, thanks to which, after initial activation, you can log in to slovensko.sk without a reader and an ID card with a chip simply by using the application.

No recent changes in governance have been reported to date.
