Legislation


The Draft <u>Digital Cloud Policy</u> was published for consultation in December 2020. The policy is expected to be published in 2021 and will establish the framework for the use of cloud solutions by public bodies.

Infrastructure

The <u>Ísland.is</u> portal was revamped, introducing digital driving licenses for phone wallets, life events, digital criminal record checks, a central web services data catalogue, and the first connections to government data were implemented through the secure X-road data exchange layer.
