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#### Data Literacy & Open Data

- Open data is predicated on sharing data as much as possible
- Requires a large cohort of skilled data creators and users
- Practice and principle are intertwined

- High skills in certain organisations
- The majority of non-specialist PS identify data skills as a requirement



#### What we're doing

- Developing the Open Data Training Framework
- Promoting coaching and knowledge exchange as part of the Technical Support Framework
- Coordinating with general training programmes to introduce data skills in general training

- Introduction to the Open Data Directive
- Open Data Audits & Data Publication
- Introduction to Data Analytics & Visualisation
- Data Anonymisation Techniques
- Introduction to Linked Data



### Course Design

- To use real data examples to teach
- Regular feedback to meet evolving needs


