The ISA² Action 2016.23. Legal Interoperability, under the ISA² programme, aims to facilitate the implementation of the European Interoperability Framework (EIF) recommendation on legal interoperability. Concretely, the action aims to address the political call "to fully integrate digital considerations into existing and future policy and regulatory initiatives", as it was expressed by the ministers in charge of e-Government policy across the European Union in their <u>Tallinn declaration</u> on 6 October 2017.

DESIGN / BUSINESS




e.g.: Decision makers, Business architects


OPERATIONAL


