Meeting Agenda

The Joinup User Group Meeting (UGM) was held online via MS Teams due to the Covid-19 situation. The meeting was organised by the Project Team and the Project Officers of the Joinup Action (2016.20) with the following agenda:

- Joinup in 2021;
- Joinup's new vision;
- The Joinup revamp.

Each section was followed by an interactive session in which the participants provided their feedback for the platform by accessing an online tool called Beekast¹. In Beekast, the Project Team created a series of questions and polls that addressed specific topics, allowing participants to provide their answers in real time and also view the results live.

Meeting Summary

Context

From October 2017 and onwards, Joinup has progressed to become a one-stop shop for interoperability solutions, and knowledge around eGovernment-related content such as factsheets, studies, and use cases supporting the digital transformation of public administrations. Moreover, the redesigned Joinup platform has been receiving major enhancements in the areas of user-friendliness, mobile usability, stability etc. During 2020 and 2021, Joinup strengthened its vision proposal in the European Digital landscape and began a major UI/UX revamp process to engage further in increasing its user base.

Introduction

The Project Officers (PO) opened the meeting by welcoming the participants and presenting the Joinup Team, the meeting's objectives, Joinup's timeline as well as Joinup users testimonials:

- <u>The Joinup Team.</u> The User Group meeting is an opportunity to present the people behind the management and development of the platform.
- <u>The meeting's objectives.</u> The User Group meeting is also responsible to communicate and keep stakeholders up-to date on the latest activities and gather feedback, requests as well as understand the needs of stakeholders.
- Timeline. The timeline offers users a brief overview of the history of the platform.
- <u>Joinup user testimonials.</u> The User Group Meeting is also the ideal place to share success stories and interesting use cases within the Joinup community.


