Public administrations adapting to the OSS development culture



A long-standing commitment to Open Source

As far back as Lutece was built

The City of Paris has developped in house its signature city services engine since 2002

1. A City Services Engine that provides

- · A modular platform based on lightweight *core* features, on which we can add the needed functionalities through the use of plug-ins
- · A solution based on <u>real needs</u> over time, in constant evolution
- · 300+ city services, 500+ plug-ins offered with a normed development framework

2. An Open Source Platform for Cities

- · Made in Java EE, enabling quick deployment of city services based on standards
- · Secure, GDPR compliant
- · Offering solutions commonly needed in a municipal context
 - A Citizen Relationship Management System (also reused internally for civil servants)
- A powerful workflow engine enabling specific actions for business apps





An Open Source Policy

Brought and sponsored by Elected Officials

300+ digital services in Paris held with Lutece

1. Make the e-administration easy

- · Easily administrable content by non-techs (CMS)
- Easy to reuse/adapt Form generator, Appointment booking system, tax simulator, etc.
- · « Tell us once » Innovative ID management using France Connect (based on OpenIdConnect)
- · Single sign-on enabled with the CRM. The citizen data being protected by a provider
- · A centralized citizen dashboard that gathers all the digital administrative procedures and their states

2. Help people get involved in the City

- · Participatory Budget, public consultations, Street problems reporting system, submit or express ideas through a suggest platform...
- · Open Source as a way to enhance trust between the Citizens and the Administration



Benefits from Open Source identified and sustained

The City of Paris as an OS user, contributor and provider

1. We foster the use of Open Source whenever possible

· Application servers, DBMS, authentication systems, ESB implementation...

2. We contribute to Open Source projects when needed

• The city co-founded Open Source projects and contributes to their roadmaps

3. We open all our developments made on the Lutece framework

- · Lutece used in all operational departments of the City
 - Quick way to develop the elected officials engagements, used as onshelf apps
- · Reused by other cities and companies in France and across the borders
 - City of Lyon, and many other cities/institutions in France in many different ways...
 - St Francis Center, Baltimore provides services for communities
 - Budapest, Hungary Reuse and contributions to OpenPB (participatory budgeting)



The choice of a facilitated adoption

Key good practices to foster the reuse of Lutece

1. A licence chosen to make it easy to reuse and hack, not to protect our codebase

· Public money should fund public code, right?

2. A controlled quality of code

- The development framework defines naming and coding rules
- · A very useful plugin wizard
- · PR-based upstream commits, online documentation and MOOC

3. A development culture deeply rooted in its application

- The culture of standardization in the architecture and development team
- · All functionalities added as plugins, modules, add-ons, or options
- The core project streamlined as much as possible, while covering all recurring features
- · A modular architecture to easily set up a BO app, a FO portal, or a WS-based microportal



A long-term effort

Adopting a collaboration culture

1. Awareness of Lutece more broadly

- · Many awards won: OW2 Best project Community 2020, Best OS Strategy in 2018, Territoria, Free Digital Territory, Human Capital Leaders, OW2 mature project in 2016...
- · Lutece featured at John's Hopkins University « Hophacks fall 2018 » for 1st-time civic track

2. An Open Source Policy to maintain

- · Board member of the OW2 consortium, and member of French FOSS Associations
- · Participation in the OSPO++ workshops for more than a year
- · Open Source City Forums held in Paris
- · Expertise from the Bloomberg Associates
- · Working w/ MossLabs for external OS positioning and consulting

3. A community management yet to be improved
