Interoperable Europe Act & Our Community

On 18 November 2022 the European Commission adopted a proposal for an Interoperable Europe Act to reinforce the interoperability of the public sector in the EU. It aims to enhance the ability of administrations to cooperate and make public services function across borders, sectors and organizations.

18 November 2022



To make EU legislation fully digital-ready and interoperableby-design, it is important to seek, and eventually ensure, a shared understanding between the co-legislators, in full respect of the roles of each Institution.

European Commission



The strategy foresees setting up an advice mechanism for digitalready policymaking to guide the lead service in charge of a new policy initiative through mandatory digital checks.

The <u>Communication</u> accompanying the Interoperable Europe Act highlights the need for digital-ready policymaking

"Digital-ready and interoperability-by-design policymaking will support the emergence of genuinely trans-European digital services"

> "The Commission's own Digital Strategy and Better Regulation agenda firmly incorporate digital thinking into the EU policy cycle, promoting the 'digital-by-default' principle in policy development"

> > > "It is important to develop transparent and reusable, digital-ready reporting and monitoring tools... the existing monitoring formats should be integrated into a 'once-only' logic, reusing data and surveys where possible and making the results openly available in machine-readable formats"



Questions addressed to European Commission, DG DIGIT, D2

Q1: How can we create a top down and back network to bring the multi-government structure of Europe and the member states, the federal states and local or special units together with opensource data and platforms?

A1: The Digital Single Gateway is about this top-down bottom-up approach and provides the tools to help implement it. The Act is really about this top-down bottom-up structure. It provides public administrators with the necessary tools. The portal could play a role and provide transparency on what subset is required based on other Acts. The community can help with topics that might not be known yet and with solutions that might no longer apply to a specific issue.

A2: This structured governance is the core of the proposal. Transparency and inclusivity is important. The six pillars can be useful in this process, and it is interesting to see how this structure can be achieved through them. For example, through the Joinup portal with a series of webinars, a platform of knowledge sharing, and how to contribute to our community.



Conversations from the chat

A1: For international cooperation we need legal and technical standards in space and on earth to use data in an effective way.

A2: Some kind of standards and good practices are into European Interoperability Framework - nonbinding (form now) instrument

A3: The European Interoperability Framework is another important element of the legislative proposal that we have not covered today. It will develop in the future and also here your (community) voice is very much welcomed!

A4: Yes. In Interoperable Europe Act, Interoperable Europe Board will get the opportunity to prepare the proposition of actualisation on this area - accepted by the European Commission. So, EIF will become binding rules for participants (countries)?

A5: The Communication accompanying the Interoperable Europe act has a short chapter on '4.4 Developing international cooperation on public sector interoperability' <u>com2022710_0.pdf (europa.eu)</u>

A6: In the Interoperability Assessments you would need to look into the alignment with the EIF.


