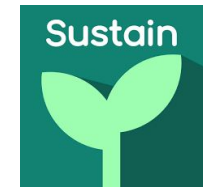

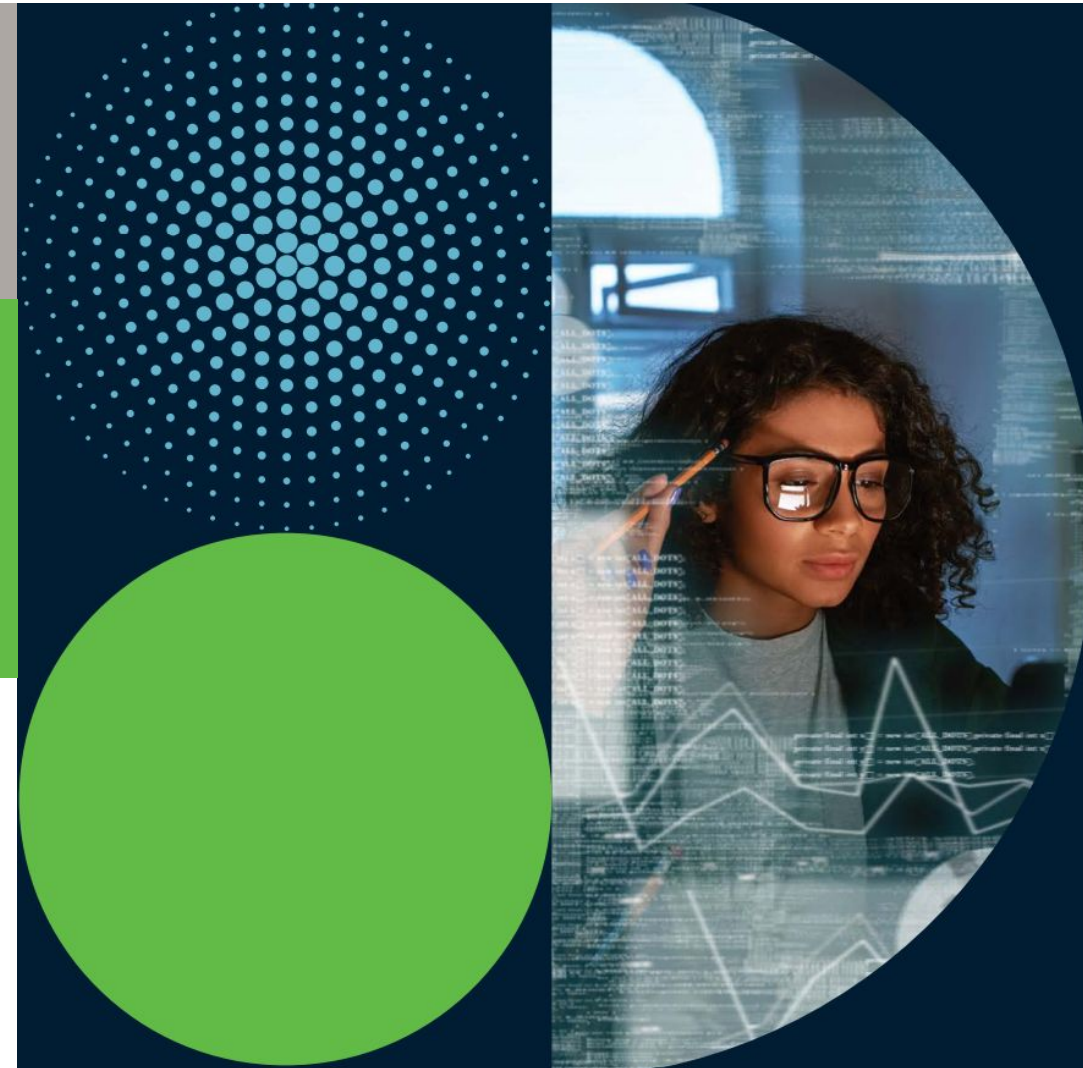

- 97% engaged in open source and/or InnerSource
 - Using OS tools
 - Integrating OSS into products / services
 - Facilitating R&D
- 12% engage in personal capacity only
- 54% formal policies governing use & contributions
- 52% awareness programs around OS/InnerSource
- 38% have an OSPO

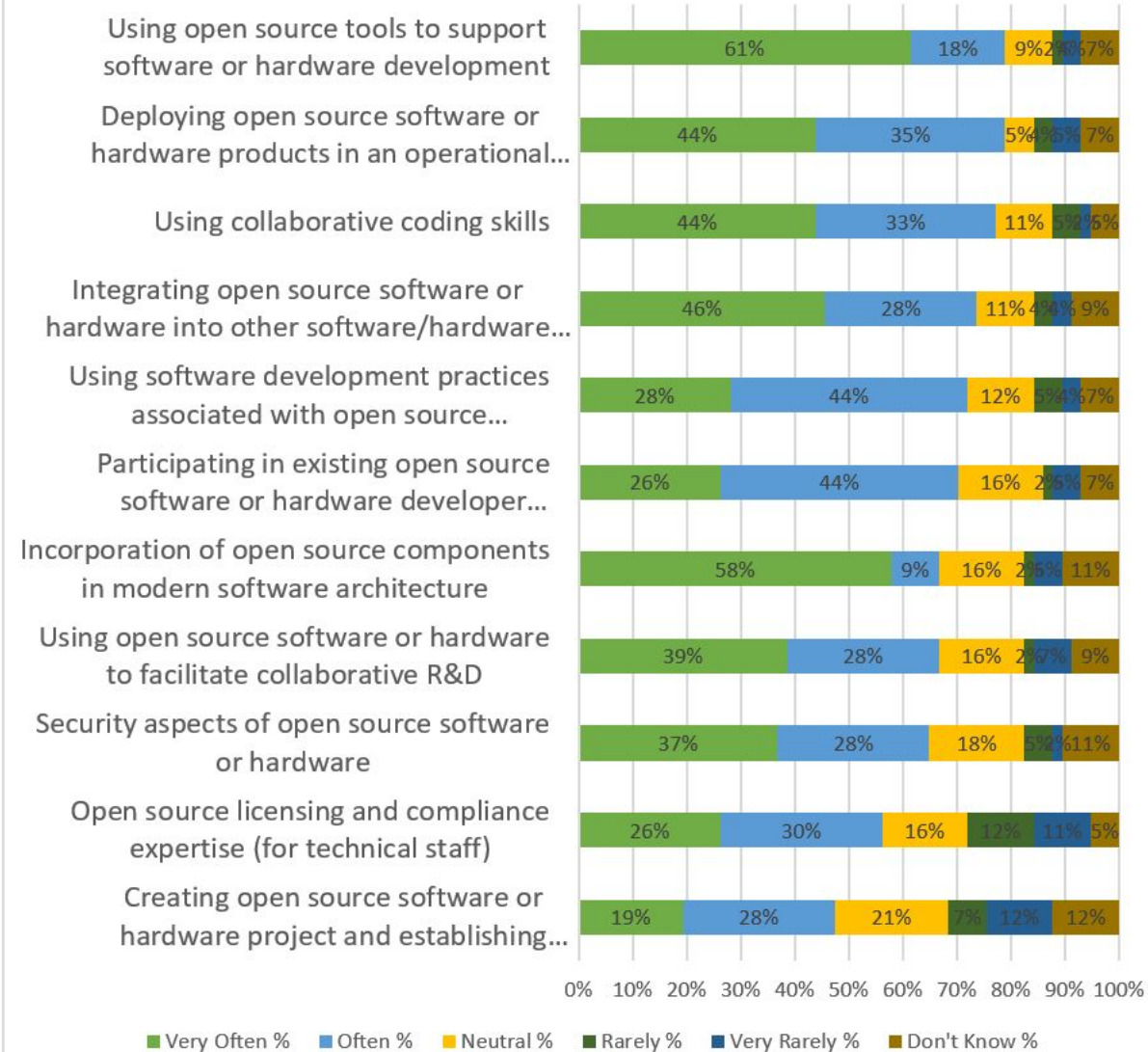

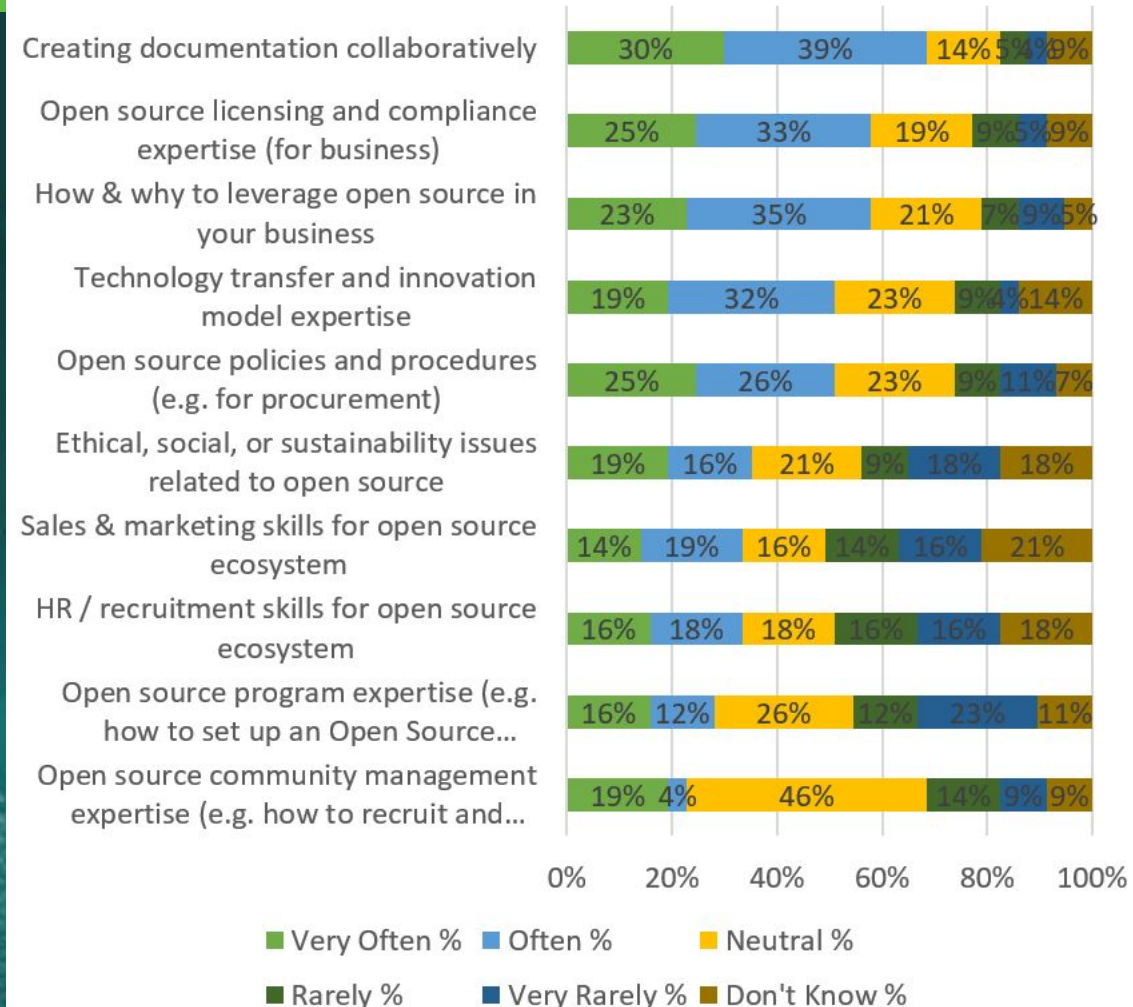
While considering hiring or professional development activities by your organizations in the upcoming 3 years, how often will the following skills appear for technical roles?

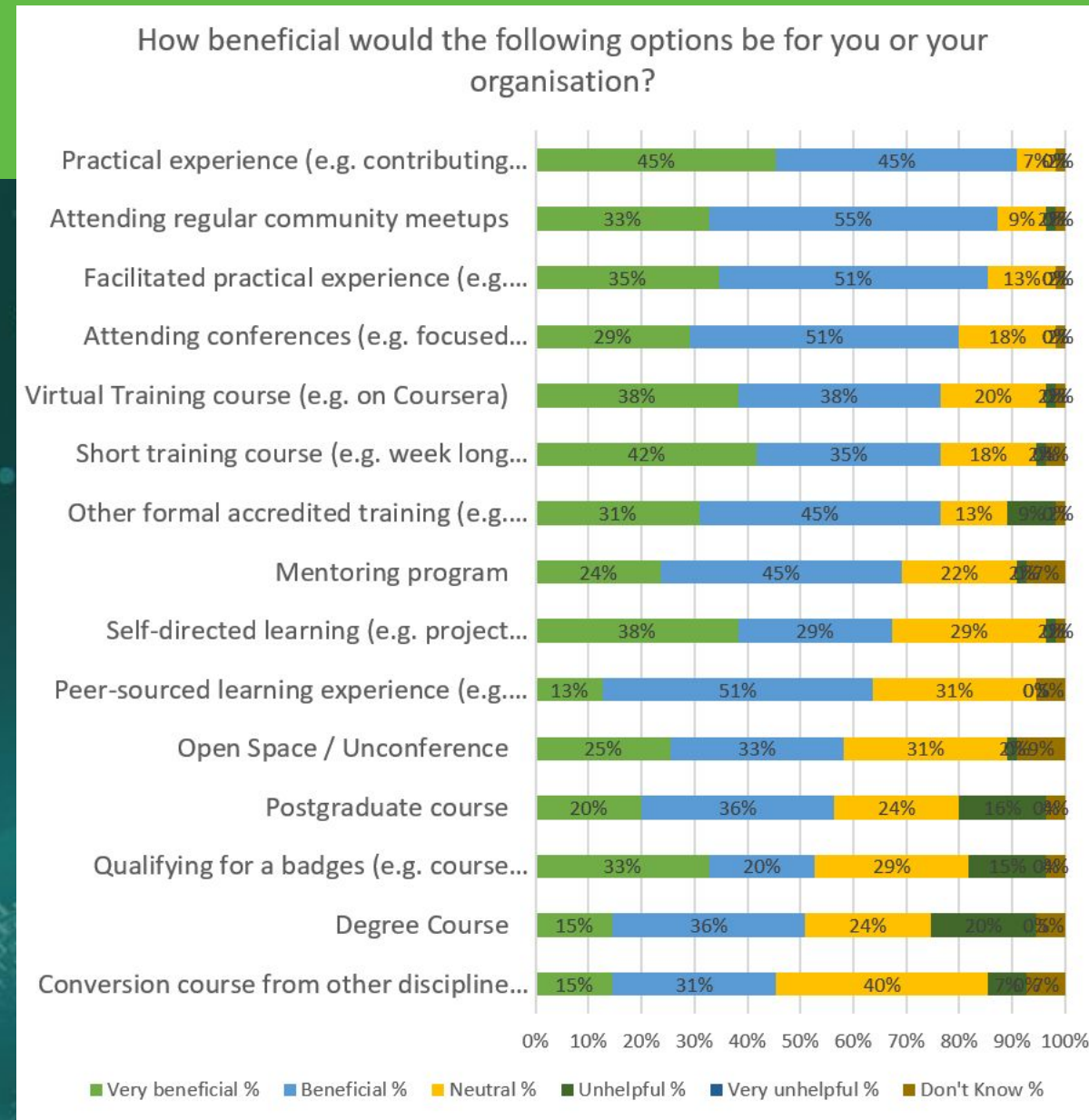

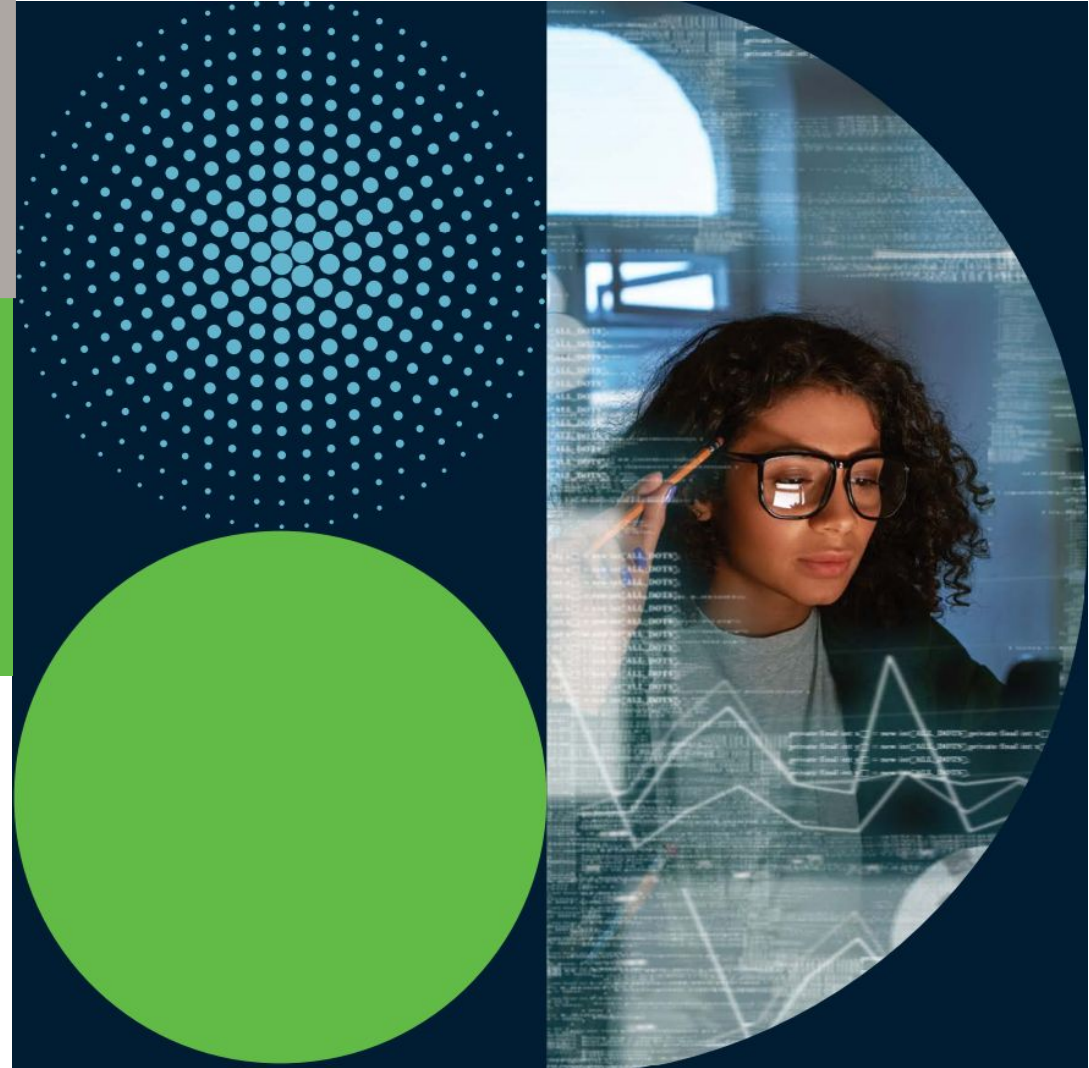
